Mr. Dinkins' wife **Joyce Dinkins** and his granddaughter joined the former mayor to see him accept his award,

- The central theme of the gala was: "The Year of the Father", with a video presentation highlighting the stories of three fathers enrolled in CCHP's Family and Employment Services Program

Becky Thomas, Director of the Early Childhood Development Center commented: "When we think of caregivers our society tends to focus on the mother and fails to consider the role of the father. At CCHP, our services focus on the entire family and that includes fathers."
